"A Course in Environmental Awareness" (Compulsory at the B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. Degree Level)

Guidelines for the conduct of the course

1. A Certificate course in Environmental Awareness with duration of six months (40 lectures) has been introduced from the academic year 2004-05 at the second year of degree course (B.A., B.Com and B.Sc.) as a compulsory course.
2. The syllabus prepared by the University is enclosed (see enclosure)
3. The details of the teaching plan are enclosed herewith
4. A proposed evaluation system has been enclosed
5. A Fee of Rs 200 per student be charged to meet the expenditure on the conduct of the course. The Utilization of Rs 200/- shall be as follows -
 - A. Rs. 50/- will be send to University of Pune.
 - B. Rs. 5/- each to Principal, Coordinator & Asstt. Coordinator per student
- 6.a. A course Coordinator be appointed to organize teaching and evaluation.
- 6.b. Coordinator will be appointed by the Principal.
7. Faculty wise Asstt. Coordinator shall be appointed in multifaculty colleges.
8. **Qualifications of a Teacher.**
University approved teacher (Lecturer) in any subject possessing substantial knowledge to teach, courses on environmental studies shall be eligible to teach the proposed course.

Principal of the College shall be authorized to decide the eligibility of the teacher, based on published work or expository articles or books written by the teacher on environmental studies or workshop/refresher course/ training programme on environmental studies attended by the teacher.
9. A candidate has to appear for this course in the Ist year / IInd Terms of the degree course.

10. a. This course can be cleared in the IIIrd year also if candidate remains absent or fails in this course in the IInd year of degree course.
- b. The candidate will have to pass in the examination of "A Course in Environmental Awareness" in order to obtain degree certificate from the University.
11. **Appointment of Examiner** : Principal shall appoint Chairman An examiner, paper setter, remuneration for Examination work shall be paid out of the fees mentioned above. The norms for payment shall be as follows.
- A. MCQ Rs. 5/- *multiple choice questions*
- B. Essay type question Rs. 5/-
- C. Field work Rs. 10/- per candidate
12. A candidate has to pass in this paper in order to obtain degree certificate. If the candidate passes in all subjects of degree course but fails in this paper, he will not obtain degree certificate.
13. This Scheme will start from academic year 2004-2005 for second year students of degree course.
14. **Examination** : The evaluation along the pattern suggested below shall be organized by the principal at the College level. The grade sheet shall be submitted to the Controller of Examination, University of Pune before the end of the University Examination's of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. The grade shall reflect on the final Mark statement of each student. The results of University examination of the student who fail to get Minimum C Grade in this course shall be Kept in reserve till the concerned students complete the course and secure the required (Minimum) Grade.

SIX MONTHS COMPULSORY CORE MODULE COURSE IN ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES FOR UNDERGRADUATES

Teaching Methodologies

The Core Module Syllabus for Environmental Studies includes class room teaching and field work. The syllabus is divided into eight units covering 50 lectures. The first seven unit will cover 45 lectures which are class room based to enhance knowledge skills and attitude to environment. Unit eight is based on field activities which will be covered in five lectures hours and would provide students first hand knowledge on various local environmental aspects. Field experience is one of the most effective learning tools for environmental concerns. This moves out of the scope of the text book mode of teaching into the realm of real learning in the field, where the teacher merely acts as a catalyst to interpret what the student observes or discovers in his/her own environment. Field studies are as essential as class work and form an irreplaceable synergistic tool in the entire learning process.

Course material provided by UGC for classroom teaching and field activities be utilized.

The universities/colleges can also draw upon expertise of outside resource persons for teaching purpose.

Environmental Core Module shall be integrated into the teaching programmes of all undergraduate courses.

Annual System: The duration of the course will be 50 lectures. The exam will be conducted along with the Annual Examination.

Semester System: The Environment course of 50 lectures will be conducted in the second semester and the examinations shall be conducted at the end of the second semester.

Credit System: The core course will be awarded 4 credits.

Exam Pattern: In case of awarding the marks, the question paper should carry 100 marks.

Part-A, Short answer pattern – 25 marks

Part-B, Essay type with inbuilt choice – 50 marks

Part-C, Field work – 25 marks





GUIDELINES FOR S-4 PAPER

GUIDELINES FOR THE CONDUCT OF PRACTICAL

1. Each batch of students should consist of 12 students.
2. If the number of students exceeds even by 1, a separate batch should be formed for conduct of practical.
3. Each batch will conduct practical twice per week with three lecture periods per session.
4. Total workload per batch will be 6 lecture periods.
5. In addition 1 separate lecture will be held for Statistics per week for the entire class.
6. Practical examination will be held annually.
7. Students should visit an industry, mental hospital, general hospital, central jail, remand home, ashram, or correctional institute / organization. The teacher accompanying the students can claim TA/DA as per the University rules.
8. The concerned teacher should verify the completion of practical journal as well as group testing or project report and issue a completion certificate signed by the head of the department.

GUIDELINES FOR ASSESSMENT (ANNUAL EXAMINATION)

1. While preparing the programme for final examination, the number of students in any given batch should not exceed 8.
2. The examiners should set paper on the spot.
3. Three subsets of question papers should be set per batch. These subsets should be considered as one set for billing purpose.
4. Before conducting the examination the external examiner should confirm that all the guidelines mentioned in the syllabus were strictly followed while teaching and conducting the practical. The examiner should also see whether the numbers of practicals are conducted as per the specifications given in the syllabus.
5. While appearing for the final examination, students must produce the fair journal containing the report of the practical duly completed and signed by the concerned teacher and head of the department. Group Testing report or Project report or Study Tour Report (whichever is applicable) should be submitted separately.
6. External Examiner should allow students to appear for final examination only on producing the Completion Certificate.
7. The structure of the question paper for S-4 will be as follows:
 - Statistics (any two problems- each problem has 10 marks)
 - Question paper/ preference sheet for practical
 - i. The question paper will contain 2 sections – section I & section II.
 - ii. Section I will contain 4 questions based on tests.
 - iii. Section II will contain 4 questions based on experiments.
 - iv. The student will give 2 preferences for each section.
 - v. Out of the four preferences given by the student, the final choice of the question to be attempted will be of the external examiner.
 - Group Testing or Project Assessment

i. Group testing- The examiner should assess group testing report and conduct viva on the following points:

- a. Purpose of the group testing
- b. Name of the test used
- c. Statistics used
- d. Results
- e. Conclusion

ii. Project- The examiner should assess project report and conduct viva on the following points:

- a. Hypothesis
- b. Sample
- c. Tools for data collection
- d. Method/s for statistical analysis
- e. Results
- f. Conclusion

iii. Study tour report- Complete observation and behavioral analysis

8. Break up of marks will be as follows: (See the Marksheet in Appendix)

- Practical Report : 15 marks



महाविद्यालयीन विद्यार्थ्यांची
आशावादी आणि निराशावादी अभिवृत्तीचा
अन्वयस करणे.

* प्रस्तावना :-

समाजशास्त्रांमधील अभिवृत्तीची
संकल्पना प्रथम वापरत आणली. समाजातील
विविध वर्गांचा जातीसमुहाऱ्या आणि धर्माचा
परस्परशीची विशील त-हेने वागण्याचा कल
अन्वयसण्यासाठी त्यांनी या संकल्पनेचा
वापर केला. अमेरिकन मानसशास्त्रांमधील
व्यक्ती पतनातील विविधता समजून घेण्या-
साठी ही संकल्पना महत्वाची वाटली. व्यक्ती
पतनावर नियंत्रण ठेवण्यासाठी व परिवर्तन
बुद्धी आणण्यासाठी या संकल्पनेचा उप-
योग होईल. हे लक्षात आल्यामुळे लवकरच
सामाजिक मानसशास्त्रात ती केंद्रित होतांना
हिसत आहे. " एखाद्या वस्तूचे किंवा
विषयाचे विशील प्रकारे मूल्यांकन करण्या-
ची प्रवृत्ती म्हणजे अभिवृत्ती होय.

* अभिवृत्तीवर परिणाम करणारे घटक :-

व्यक्तीच्या अभिवृत्ती अनुवंशीक
किंवा जन्मसिद्ध नसतात. अस्थायी प्रक्रियेतून
अपहित केल्या जातात. समाधान मिळविणे
आणि असमाधान रावणे या दोन अस्थिर

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दिलेले व्यक्तीचे वर्तन कायचित् झालेले असते. त्यातून अभिवृत्ती तयार होते. अभिवृत्ती वर ज्या व्यक्तीच्या परिणाम हिस्सून येतो. तो धरक पुढीलप्रमाणे :-

1. स्वतःचे अनुभव किंवा साण :-

व्यक्तीचे जीवन त्याच्या मुलभूत गरजा आणि सामाजिक गरजांशी निगडित असते. अशापैकी ज्या व्यक्तीकडून त्याका महत्त्व मिळते, प्रोत्साहन मिळते. त्याच्या विषयी प्रेम, आपुणकी वाहू लागते. त्याच्याशी संबंध वाढवणे पारत. अशिले पुढीलच्या आड येणाऱ्या व्यक्तीविरुद्ध प्रतिकूल अभिवृत्ती निर्माण होतात. व्यक्तीला येणाऱ्या विविध अनुभवांमधून व्यक्तीचे साण वाढते हे साण अभिवृत्तीच्या परिवर्तनात महत्त्वपूर्ण भूमिका बजावते.

2. सांस्कृतीचा अभाव किंवा समाजाचा प्रभाव :-

सांस्कृतिक, सामाजिक निव्यामके अभिवृत्तीची निर्मिती आणि विकास करण्यास कारणीभूत ठरतात. ज्या समाजात व्यक्ती जन्माका येते. वाढते. त्या समाजाचे काही नीती - निशम, खडी परंपरा, आचार - विचार असतात. त्यातून त्या व्यक्ती समाजाची जीवनपद्धती व संस्कृती तयार होत असते. एका पिढीकडून दुसऱ्या पिढीकडे त्या सांस्कृतीचा वाक्या पुढे जात असतो.

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3. समवयस्कतांचा प्रभाव :-

सामान्यता व्यक्तीच्या अभिवृत्ती व्याख्याशी संबंधित असलेल्या समुदायांमिलल्यामुळे असतात. समवयस्कतांचा समुह हा व्यक्तीवर्तनावर प्रभाव पडणारा महत्वाचा घटक असतो अशा समुहामध्ये व्यक्तीच्या प्रतिष्ठा, मान्यता स्वीकृती समवयस्कतांच्या मनीसच्या मुल्यांच्या अभिवृत्तीच्या परिवाराम व्यक्तीवर होत असतो.

4. वैदग्ध्य समुहाचा प्रभाव :-

व्यक्ती प्रत्यक्षात ज्या समुहाचा सदस्य असतो. तो त्याच्या सभासद समुह होय. परंतु व्यक्तीला दृष्ट्याच्या समुहाचा सदस्य असावे असेही वास्तव. ज्या समुहाचा सदस्य त्याला व्हावेसे वास्तव. ज्या समुहाच्या मुल्यांच्या मानदंडांच्या आणि अभिवृत्तीच्या व्यक्ती जाणीवपूर्वक स्वीकार करत असतो.

* समस्या :-

कका शास्त्रेतील आणि वाणिज्य शास्त्रेतील विद्याश्याप्ती आशावादी आणि निराशावादी अभिवृत्ती तपासणे.

* वृत्तिक :-

वाणिज्य शास्त्रेतील विद्याश्याप्तीस कका शास्त्रेतील विद्याश्याप्तीस आशावादी अभिवृत्ती विस्मृत होते.

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* संशोधन पद्धती :-

1) नमुना निवड :-

महाविद्यालयात एकूण 30 विद्यार्थी होतले. त्यापैकी 15 विद्यार्थी फक्त शाखेतील असून 15 विद्यार्थी वाणिज्य शाखेतील निवडले आहेत.

2) मापनतंत्रे :-

आशावादी आणि निराशावादी हि चाचणी डी.एस. पारादर यांची असून त्यामध्ये एकूण 40 प्रश्न आहे. सर्व प्रश्नांसमोर सहमत आणि असहमत असे दोन पर्याय दिसून येतात. हि चाचणी सोडवण्यासाठी वेळेची मर्यादा नाही पण तसे ली आपण कमीत कमी वेळेत सोडवण्याचा प्रयत्न केला पाहिजे.

3) सांख्यिकीय तंत्रे :-

सर्व प्रकल्पासाठी संख्याशास्त्रामधून "मध्य" या तंत्राचा वापर केला आहे.

* फलिते :-

महाविद्यालयीन विद्यार्थ्यांची आशावादी आणि निराशावादीचा अभ्यास करणे. मी हा विषय निवडला असून, या विषयामध्ये एकूण 30 विद्यार्थी निवडले असून त्यांचे दोन समूहामध्ये विभागले

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केले आहे. कृक शाखेतील ३५ विद्यार्थी व वाणिज्य शाखेतील ३५ विद्यार्थी यांची एकूण "मध्य" हे सांख्यिकीय तंत्र वापरून पुढील फलिते मिळाली.

परिल लक्षात कृक शाखेच्या विद्यार्थ्यांचा मध्य ३९ आला आहे व वाणिज्य शाखेचा मध्य २९ आला आहे यावरून असे दिसते वाणिज्य शाखेचा मध्य कृक शाखेपेक्षा कमी आहे. यावरून कृक शाखेचे विद्यार्थी वाणिज्य शाखेच्या विद्यार्थ्यांपेक्षा जास्त आशावादी आहे.

*** निष्कर्ष :-**

परिल फलितानुसार कृक शाखेच्या विद्यार्थ्यांपेक्षा वाणिज्य शाखेचे विद्यार्थी कमी आशावादी आहे. वाणिज्य शाखेचा मध्य कृक शाखेपेक्षा कमी असल्याने असे स्पष्ट होते की, वाणिज्य शाखेपेक्षा कृक शाखेचे विद्यार्थी जास्त आशावादी आहेत.

यावरून असे आढळून येते की, प्रथम वर्गाच्या कुमियांच्या मध्ये आशावादी जास्त प्रमाणात आहे.
