Section-III: Overall analysis based on Institutional Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Challenges (SWOC) (300 to 500 words)

Strengths:

The College was established in 2003 and since then has shown consistent growth in quality education. The college tries to promote the research culture among the faculty members which resulted in publishing 05 research papers and book in chapter 06. Also, 04 LCD projectors available in the college and 36 computers are available in the college except office computers. The NSS unit organized various extension activities such as *Meri Mitti Mera Desh*, *Bharat Swachhata Abhiyan*, *Andhshraddha Nirmulan (Eradication of Superstition)*, *Harit Saptah* and *Tree Plantation Programme*. The Central library of the college has been facilitated with good number of books related to Competitive Examination. We have used OPEC software for students and teachers. The college has good initiatives to direct access of Jaykar Library SPPU, Pune. The college actively implemented N-List facility to teachers for their research work. The college has successfully worked towards gender equity promotion and sensitivity by organizing many programs and activities under Student Development Council.

Weaknesses:

The college is of 20 years old but has yet to start PG programmes and therefore it is not a recognized research center. The college has not made any attempt to generate corpus funds as well as getting funds from some funding agencies.

Opportunities:

The college offers very few programmes and has good opportunity to introduce some Post Graduate and Skills Based programmes. Being Agricultural background to this college, there is a scope to start a Diploma course in Agriculture.

Challenges:

Being tribal and rural area, the college has great challenge in fulfilling the enrolments of students for various programmes. It's more challenging to train the students from this background for the courses due to weakness of students at basics.

We have gone through the observation and recommendations in this report made by the AAA Expert team for Quality enhancement of the College. We agree to aforesaid observations and recommendations.




